About Janet

Janet's commitment to the Association over more than 25 years was constant and absolute. She joined the Association after its inaugural meeting in 1977 and her daughter, Georgina, was diagnosed with TSC shortly afterwards. She became volunteer secretary in 1986, and was appointed as Head of Support Services in 1991, a post which she held until her untimely death in 2006.

At her funeral donations amounted to over £11,000, and after much thought and discussion with her family, it was felt that Janet would have chosen for this money to be used to provide help and support to family carers or those living with TSC.

Who can apply?

If you care for someone, who, due to TSC, can't manage without your help, then you are a carer and can apply. If you are an adult with TSC you can apply. You can apply for yourself, be nominated by a TSC advisor or by someone who you know. All we ask is that you are a member of the TSA.
