



Travel insurance for pre-existing medical conditions

It is important to make sure that your travel insurance covers you for a 'pre-existing medical condition'. Most standard policies do not provide this type of cover. The TSA is unable to recommend specific insurance providers however the following are specialist insurance brokers for people with pre-existing medical conditions or companies who have received favourable publicity in this area in the past. It is recommended that you shop around and gather quotes for comparison.

If travelling in Europe you should also carry a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) (which replaces the E111). For more information phone 0845 606 2030 or see www.ehic.org.uk or pick up an application form from your Post Office.
